

CTU G UPDATES AND GUIDELINES

CTU-G continues to be an acute medicine service, but with no or limited housestaff. It is generally run by an Attending and Physician Assistant.

The following modifications apply to CTU-G:

- Cap of 15 patients
 - Attending may increase cap at their discretion, particularly if discharges are anticipated
- Maximum of 2 admissions overnight
 - *No D4 Admissions overnight*
- No 'holdovers' for the G attending
- No D4 admissions in general , except:
 - If a CTU-G ward patient is transferred to D4, the CTU-G Attending will decide if that patient is transferred to another team, or remain on G.
- Boucebacks to G are acceptable, similar to other CTU teams given continuity of the PA. Bouncebacks are included in overnight number of admissions and patient cap, unless otherwise indicated by the G Attending
- CTU-E will preferentially admit longer stay patients to G in the mornings as long as G has capacity
- Procedures- contact Senior in ED after 1pm to determine most appropriate team/availability for procedures for G patients (this allows juniors on other CTU teams to have the opportunity to perform and learn procedures)
