Taking Call for Hotel Dieu Johnson 3 (CTU-J)

Background

CTU-J is an acute medicine ward based on Johnson 3 at Hotel Dieu. Because the patients on this unit are typically of lower acuity compared to CTU patients at KGH, on-call coverage at night can generally be taken from home. Below are the expectations and procedures for call.

Expectations and Procedures

- Take handover on ward patients by 5pm the day of the call
- Accept new/pending admissions from KGH from 5pm until 8pm
 - Review the admission with the admitting resident (or transferring resident) from KGH
 - Assess the patient on arrival to the unit to ensure the patient is stable and the admission orders are appropriate
 - Write a brief accept note
- Respond to all pages at night
- Come in when needed (unstable patients and patients needing direct physician assessment)
- Provide handover to the team in the morning at 8am

Additional Information

- CTU-J has a resident handover in PCS that should be kept up to date by the daytime team
- There is a call room on Johnson 3 if needed
