

CRITERIA FOR TIME HALL OF FAME

TIME Hall of Fame

TIME HALL of FAME will highlight new grants and high-impact publications which meet the following criteria:

Publications:

- Published in a peer-reviewed journal with an impact factor equal to or more than five.
- Publication with TIME Members. Must be a listed author
- Published within the last three months
- The paper should be available online

Grants:

- Grants received from Tri-council or National Foundation with a dollar amount of more than \$50K/year.

Please Note:

- TIME Hall of FAME will not be restricted by number; we can post stuff as it becomes available. For example, if someone receives a significant grant or publishes a paper, it will be highlighted immediately.
- TIME members will be requested to send their publications to Salwa; if it meets the above criteria, they will be highlighted in the TIME Hall of Fame after being reviewed and approved by the TIME Director.
- The selected research group will be invited to record a podcast and discuss the published research work with Dr. Hindmarch. This Podcast will be recorded in the Queen's Radio Station CRFC and will be added to the TIME podcast series, Research TIME.

CRITERIA FOR TIME SHOWCASE

TIME SHOWCASE: Celebrating Excellence in Research

TIME SHOWCASE will highlight at least one publication by a TIME member (GFT) and one publication by a student/trainee supervised by a TIME Member every month. Publications should meet the following criteria:

- Inclusive of any research and publication that involves a TIME faculty member as the named author
- Publications with the trainee/student as the first author. Must also be supervised by a TIME faculty member
- Published within the last three months
- The paper should be available online

Please Note:

- TIME Showcase provides a platform for early researchers and students to highlight their publications.
- TIME members are requested to share their students' publications with Salwa.
- Publications will be highlighted on first come basis.
