<p>On call for ER consults on take day & your CTU team x-cover</p> <p><u>ER consults (1pm-6am) if on CTU-take team; otherwise 5pm-6am.</u></p> <p>Report to the on-call senior or night float resident who will distribute consults to you. Review consults with your senior and Attending staff</p> <p><u>Ward Coverage</u> You will cover your own CTU team at night</p> <p>(Back-up from in house Medicine R3 & RACE team)</p> <p>Expect to receive handover from your team at 5pm (noon on w/e & holidays)</p>	<p>On call for ER consults on take day & your CTU team x-cover</p> <p><u>ER consults (1pm-6am) if on CTU-take team; otherwise 5pm-6am</u></p> <p>Report to the on-call senior or night float resident who will distribute consults to you. Review consults with your senior and Attending staff</p> <p><u>Ward Coverage</u> You will cover your own CTU team at night</p> <p>(Back-up from in house Medicine R3 & RACE team)</p> <p>Expect to receive handover from your team at 5pm (noon on w/e & holidays)</p>	<p>Ward x-cover for non-take CTUs, IMU H [hospitalist service] and Palliative</p> <p><u>Ward Coverage</u> Expect to receive handover at 5pm (noon on w/e & holidays)</p> <p>IMU H coverage starts at 8am on w/e & holidays</p> <p>Responsible for any medical issues for these patients overnight</p> <p>(Back-up from in house Medicine R3 & RACE team)</p> <p>Handover back to primary teams by 8.30am next morning</p>	<p>Ward coverage for Cardiology, Neurology, CTU E, Med Onc, Hematology, Nephro and GI patients</p> <p><u>Ward Coverage</u> Expect to receive handover at 5pm (noon on w/e & holidays)</p> <p>Responsible for any medical issues for these patients overnight</p> <p>Back-up from in house Medicine R3 [Neuro, CTU E, Med Onc, Heme, Nephro, GI] and Cardiology Senior [Cardiology ward]: & RACE team</p> <p>Handover back to primary teams by 8.30am next morning</p> <p>Rarely may get direct to floor admissions for Cardiology, Hematology & Neurology that need an admission note & orders</p>

NOTE: post-call rounding is expected; protected rounding time from 6:00-8:00am for R1s on ER call. If on-call during a weekend, you will likely also be responsible for weekend rounding on CTU or Cardio wards.
