Criteria for Referral

The Pleural Space Clinic is a procedural clinic in which respirologists perform diagnostic and therapeutic thoracenteses and place intrapleural catheters (PleurX™) for management of pleural effusions. The clinic only serves <u>ambulatory</u> patients. Patients may be referred directly from Respirology or Oncology. Other patients may require a Respirology consultation before being seen in the clinic.

The clinic is offered every <u>Tuesday</u>.
